## Recycling and Refuse Disposal

### Permits for Transfer Station:

Permits can be purchased for \$30 from the Elba Town Hall, Monday through Friday between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. or at the transfer station during its hours of operation.

### Transfer Station Operating Hours:

The Elba transfer station is open Saturday 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

### Recyclables and instructions:

Recycle	What	How	Do Not Include
<b>Glass</b>	Food jars including home canning jars, beverage bottles.	Remove caps and lids, rinse clean.	Broken glass or light bulbs, window glass, mirror glass, etc.
<b>Magazines/ Newspapers/ Cardboard</b>	* Clean, dry newspapers, inserts, comics, flyers & catalogs, cardboard		Hard covered books.
<b>Plastics</b>	Frosted, colored & clear plastics.	Remove caps, drain and rinse.	Plastic bags, wrap, caps, medicine bottles & toys.
<b>Tin &amp; Aluminum Cans</b>	Food or beverage aluminum & tin or metal cans.	Remove caps, drain and rinse.	
<b>Metal</b>	Washers, dryers, stoves, pipes, lawn mowers, **refrigerators, etc.	Put in appropriate place.	Car or truck gas tanks.

\* We encourage disposal/recycling of paper products in the school's bin.

\*\* Certification that the Freon has been removed must be provided when disposing of refrigerators. Look in the Yellow Pages under "REFRIGERATION" for a licensed contractor to remove the Freon.

**Annual Dump Day** – the town opens the transfer station to the town residents so they can dispose of large household items. No demolition materials or items considered toxic will be accepted. Date to be announced in May.
